Proof of NC Residency

Before any student can apply for enrollment at ArtSpace Charter School, the student's parent or legal guardian* must provide proof of permanent residency (or being domiciled) in North Carolina.

Effective March 2009, all applications must include proof of residency.

All documents must be pre-printed with the name and NC address of the student's parent or legal guardian* and must be presented at the time of application.

Document can be:

- *copy of Deed OR record of most recent mortgage payment
- *copy of Lease
- *residency affidavit from landlord affirming tenancy AND record of most recent rent payment
- *section 8 agreement
- *letter from approved agency (group & foster home purposes only)
- *a utility bill dated within the past 30 days, including: gas, water, electric, landline phone, cable.
- *valid NC driver's license
- *valid NC photo identification card
- *vehicle tax bill (dated within the past year)
- *property tax bill (dated within the past year)
- *Medicaid card (dated within the past 60 days)
- *payroll stub (dated within the past 60 days)
- *bank or credit card statement (dated within the past 60 days)

**Legal guardianship requires additional documentation from a court or agency.*

This residency proof does not apply to homeless students, as defined by the McKinney-Vento Act.

"In order to be qualified to enroll in a charter school, a student must be entitled to attend school in North Carolina. Pursuant to NC General Statutes, Section 115C-366(a), only a student who is domiciled in North Carolina may attend school here. A student's domicile is based upon the domicile (permanent residence) of his or her parents. A student whose domicile is outside of North Carolina is not 'qualified' to enroll in a charter school The charter school is authorized to, and should require documentation establishing the legal domicile of an applicant for admission to the school."
